

Reframe cancer screening and awareness

Our enhanced cancer screening service promotes early detection through testing, supports onward GP referral where abnormal results are detected and enables people to advocate for their own health based on their cancer risk factors.

We provide a personalised risk assessment report, assessing risk and eligibility for screening for 6 common cancer types, including NHS cancer screening. The report also includes personalised health guidance enabling people to make informed decisions to reduce their risk.

Our innovative approach to screening and awareness helps improve health outcomes and reduces the cost of cancer for businesses.



The importance of early cancer detection

1 in 2 people in the UK will get cancer. In working age populations (25-49) cancer incidence has increased by 24%¹, the highest increase across all age groups. Cancer is the main cause of new claims across group risk², and absence related to cancer costs UK businesses £1.6bn.



- Signposting to NHS screening the user is eligible for, before offering private screening tests, to encourage uptake of national screening programmes

Anyone receiving an abnormal result will be contacted by one of our Cancer Nurse Specialist's who will discuss the results, answer any questions and support the individual to take the next steps such as onward GP referral for any further necessary investigations.
